From the Desk: Poverty of Spirit.

In the Beatitudes, Jesus starts with reference to the 'poor in spirit'. This starting place points to the significance of recognizing how spiritually bankrupt we are in our own strength before God.

The poor in spirit are people who recognize their total inability to save themselves. This realization is the source of true humility and brings complete dependence on God.

Regardless of material accomplishments, educational achievements, or even religious knowledge and church involvement, we are all spiritually impoverished without the Gospel of Jesus Christ. However, only the poor in spirit can see this. Such was Saint Augustine as he expressed in his "Confessions" that pride was his greatest barrier to salvation.

There is only comfort in God's presence, when we realize we are undeserving to be there. To discover this comfort requires that we become poor in spirit before God.
