FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK:

The second major tenant of the reformation is Sola Christos. Commonly known as "*In Christ Alone*". This truth makes Christianity exclusive by nature as it establishes that salvation comes through no other means other than Christ's death, burial and resurrection. It is by Christ and Christ alone that sin is forgiven. It is by Christ and Christ alone that the Spirit dwells within us to conform us into His image. Jesus is the only way the only truth and he alone is the only one who grants eternal life. He is our all in all.

Christ is our vicarious, substitutionary sacrifice for sin. This fact provides certainty, security, hope and encouragement. Christ's righteousness has been credited to our account; our sin has been placed on Him. God's righteous wrath is satisfied because of Christ's perfect atonement on our behalf. Through Christ and Christ alone we are justified, reconciled, forgiven and redeemed. As Ulrich Zwingli, a Swiss reformer says, "*Through Christ alone we are given salvation, blessedness, grace, pardon, and all that makes us in any way worthy in the sight of a righteous God.* Salvation is all about Christ. Our life on this earth is all about Christ, the future eternal glory is all about Christ. In Christ alone our hope is found.
